We hope that you all had a lovely spring break and are ready for an exciting term. Below are details of what we will be learning as well as some useful information for the term ahead.

<p>Literacy and English</p> <p>In reading, we will be looking at both fiction and non-fiction texts.</p> <p>Our non-fiction texts will be linked to our topic - Enterprise, where we will look at the vocabulary, grammar and punctuation used in recipes and instructions.</p> <p>Our fiction texts will encourage our reading for pleasure, and we will discuss the author's choice of language around characters, plot and setting.</p> <p>Additional time will also be given to reading for enjoyment supported by the class library and online app 'Epic'.</p>	<p>Literacy and English</p> <p>In writing, we will be focusing on writing instructions/recipes for things to bake/ make and sell as part of our enterprise project and persuasive writing to advertise the businesses and products we create .</p> <p>Grammar and punctuation we are continuing to punctuate sentences consistently accurately and developing interesting vocabulary. In addition, we will be revising and developing persuasive language and use of imperative verbs.</p> <p>Spelling will concentrate on magic e with prefixes and suffixes. a-e, i-e, o-e, u-e, ing, d/ed/ied, er/est/iest, s/es/ies , re, dis, mis, un, ex We will also practice our common words.</p>	<p>Numeracy and Mathematics</p> <p>Throughout the year we will be using White Rose Education to support our Numeracy and Maths lessons.</p> <p>In numeracy, we will be focusing on fractions and introduce decimals and percentages.</p> <p>We will also be learning about:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Mental Maths- completing weekly beat that tests• Money: We will link this to our enterprise project and learn about budgeting, managing money and profit and loss.
<p>Learning Across the Curriculum</p> <p>We are continuing to work with and support our Primary one buddies.</p> <p>Health and Well-Being we will be looking at: the affect our actions have on others, what qualities we love about ourselves and others and names of body parts (https://rshp.scot/second-level/)</p> <p>Topic this term will span across 4 areas of the curriculum - Literacy, Numeracy, Technologies and Social Studies. In our enterprise topic, children will create their own businesses and products to sell to raise money for an end of term trip. They will learn how to budget to make a maximum profit.
